Region 2-6A Championship – February 2-3, 2017

One week after the Mustangs claimed their first ever 6A district title they headed to the Regional swim meet in Lewisville. The meet was comprised of 31 teams from every 6A district in the Dallas area. The Mustangs faced the best swimmers from each of these schools and several other district champions. The Mustangs had 18 men and women qualify for the meet. When the season started the Mustangs had a goal of improving upon last year's regional ranking and finish in the top 5. The competition was very tough with reigning state champion Southlake Carroll and several top 20 teams in the state all competing for the chance to go to state.

Relays proved to be big for the Men and Women. Every relay posted a season best time to finish the season. The Boys 200 Medley relay broke its own school record set at District to go 1:37.01. The relay included Charles Broad, Jack Delfeld, Hayden Steed, and Bennett Maczka. The Boys 400 Free relay with Jack Delfeld, Bennett Broad, Hayden Steed, and Bennett Maczka demolished a season best time to finish at 3:13.15 and got a call up to the state meet in Austin.

Nearly every swimmer on the team finished the meet with a best time. The Mustangs finished 4th behind Southlake Carroll, Allen, and Flower Mound. We broke a school record and qualified for the State meet in Austin. It was a great day for JJ Pearce swimming.
